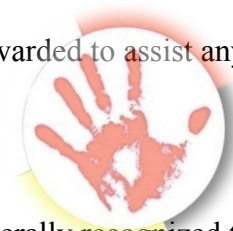
The New Mexico Native American Indian Nurses Association is a non-profit organization that proudly supports nursing excellence through student mentorship and scholarship opportunities!
