- Applicant be actively attending an accredited NM Nursing Program. In good academic standing and attending a nursing program for the Spring 2024 term.

Award information: **Limited** numbers of student success awards available. Students must be open to a mentor assignment and attend a student success session after selection. Date TBD.

Discuss any professional, community service, or student nurse association activity involvement. Indicate awards, accomplishments, research or volunteer projects you have engaged in.

Letter of recommendation from a current Nursing School Faculty. **Must be on school's official letterhead.** One nurse faculty recommendation please.

All application materials must be received no later than midnight **January 12, 2024.**

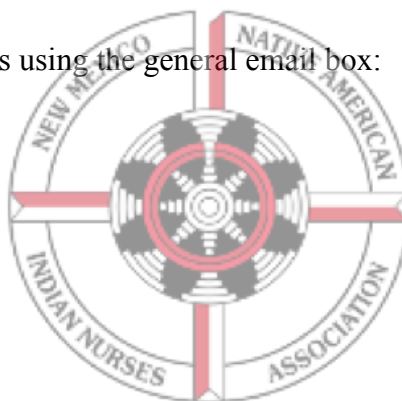
